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**Present:** Board Members: Paul Jewett, Danielle Corti, Emmy Hausman

**Call to order:** P. Jewett called the meeting to order at 8:30 AM.

**Waiver of Objection to Presiding Judge:** D. Corti moved and E. Hausman seconded a motion to have Chairperson P. Jewett sign the Waiver of Objection to Presiding Judge Mary Miles Teachout's Disclosure Request that was sent to all plaintiffs in the Act 46 suit. Motion passed. P. Jewett signed the Waiver. It was then scanned and sent by email to Attorney David Kelley ([davidkelley05602@gmail.com](mailto:davidkelley05602@gmail.com)) and Donna Waters ([Donna.Waters@vermont.gov](mailto:Donna.Waters@vermont.gov)).

**Other Business:** The issue with the lights on the north and west side of the school building being off at 8:15 PM but back on at 11:30 PM was discussed. Board members were shown the timer switch inside the front door that theoretically was set to have lights off all night until 5:30 AM. It was ascertained that one person entered the school building during the previous evening. Barring the unlikelihood that said staff person flicked the switch on the timer, turning the north and west lights on, the issue is with the settings on the timer. P. Jewett will ask Principal Lindsley to insist that Shannon Young assess and correct the problem, once getting word that the staff member had no involvement with the switch.

Concern over the lack of plowing and sanding of the fire lane in front of the school was also raised and discussed.

D. Corti moved the approval of the January 7th, 2019 Accounts Payable Warrant in the amount of \$8743.05 and authorized P. Jewett, Board Chair, to sign. E. Hausman seconded. Motion passed.

**Executive Session:** P. Jewett moved that the Board enter Executive Session to discuss negotiations. E. Hausman seconded the motion. Approved.

The Board came out of Executive Session at 10:15; no action taken.

**Adjournment:** P. Jewett moved adjournment at 10:15; D. Corti seconded. Meeting adjourned.
