Review 1st Draft of FY22 Budget:

Scenarios re: # of personnel

1. FTE's staying the same as right now Add 1.6 teachers to the budget for next year.
2. Covid significantly reduced, would save \$ with buses
3. What have we learned and discovered that may help the school with new ideas going forward

TA Tuition: \$100,000 increase or more; TA is losing fewer seniors than TES is sending on.

Discussion:

- TA still hasn't discussed tuition for next year.
- Second language is something that has made TES special.
- Buttrey - is the town-wide appraisal this year? Clark - will be in 2021 or 2022
