

Good Afternoon BMU!

We have completed contact tracing of all currently confirmed cases and those identified as close contacts have been notified.

We have made the decision that all grades PreK through 12 will remain at step 1/remote learning for all of next week.

Middle and high school classes will follow the class schedule for remote Wednesday classes – 45 minutes per class in the morning with afternoons for work/study time and make up/intervention time.

Middle school specials/unified arts classes (Art, Music and PE) students in grades 7 & 8 will receive assignments from these teachers on Monday. Students will not have to sign into specials/UA classes on Zoom but can use 11:05 – 11:50 to work on these assignments. The assignments will be due to teachers on the assigned dates.

For elementary grades - schedules will be modified for full class/group instruction to happen in the morning and makeup/intervention time in the afternoon. Teachers will share specific grade level schedules with students Monday morning.

Meals will be delivered via the school busses on Monday and Tuesday. Wednesday's delivery will be for the remainder of the week (Wednesday, Thursday and Friday). Busses will depart BMU on these three days at 11:00am

There will be no athletics/practices for next week. This will include baseball, softball, and baton. Once we know a date for athletics/practices to resume, the date will be communicated out.

As a reminder, the week of April 19th is Spring break.

We hope everyone will get a chance to get outside and enjoy the beautiful weather. Thank you.
