August 2019 - November 15, 2019

133 total incidents

August 2020 - November 15, 2020

150 total incidents

August 2021 - November 15, 2021

80 total incidents

Our overall number of referrals have decreased substantially in comparison to previous years. One trend that is noteworthy is the number of suspensions. There has been an uptick in suspendable offenses within the middle and high schools.

August 2019 - June 2020 (entire school year)

29 total suspensions

August 2020 - June 2021 (entire school year)

28 total suspensions

August 2021 - November 15, 2021 (first twelve weeks of school)

17 total suspensions

I attribute these suspensions to an increase in aggressive behaviors both physical and verbal in nature. An additional area of concern based on the suspension totals is possession of tobacco products (vape).

A large number of our students are showing steady gains from a behavioral perspective and that should not be lost in viewing this information.
